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The 9 Principles

Work with the people who use services: *People who use or work in a service improve it together*

All voices should be heard (especially *people who use a service* and *front line staff*)

Hear from those with lived experiences and support them to tell their story

Make sure there are benefits to those involved in 'working together' activities











The 9 Principles continued

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Go to *individuals or communities* to engage with them

- Work flexibility *so everyone can help*
- 7 Avoid jargon, give the right information at the right time
